Dear parents/carers,

Following our Q&A drop in session on Thursday, there were a few common questions that we wanted to address as you get ready for our residential trip to Manor Adventure on Monday 18th June.

What time do children need to be in school on Monday?

Pupils will need to come to school at normal time on Monday for registration. We will be departing George Street at approximately 12:00pm and stopping for a picnic lunch en route; please provide your child with drinks and a morning snack as well as their packed lunch.

If your child suffers with travel sickness please make sure they take any medication that is required before coming to school. Also please remember to provide your child with any medication for the duration of the trip and the journey home; place all medication in a clearly labelled bag/tub with a note with the times/dosages required – these must be handed to a teacher on Monday morning.

What does my child need to wear to school?

Pupils can wear their own clothes to school on Monday; just make sure it's something comfortable to travel in as our journey is around 1hr 30mins.

Do I need to buy waterproofs for my child?

Manor Adventure provided us with a kit list that has recommended items to pack, the list included waterproofs. If you are able to supply your child with waterproofs, please do so as we a limited supply we can loan to children. Although there are wet activities, the weather forecast is good so we are hoping for sunny skies! If you are happy for your child to wear old clothing and get a bit wet that's fine by us!

How many pairs of trousers/tops etc. should I pack for my child?

In order to help you determine exactly what to pack, we have included an activity timetable with this letter, which shows what each group will do on each day. Please note that the children know which activity groups they are in. The activities that are highlighted are water based activities so the children could get wet! Please supply an empty carrier bag for wet clothes.

Are children allowed to take spending money?

Children can bring up to £5.00. If there is a souvenir shop on site, they will be allowed to buy something however the children will not be allowed to use vending machines. If you would like to provide them with a few treats/snacks they can enjoy them in their free time.

What time will I need to collect to my child on Wednesday?

We will be departing Manor Lake at 1:30pm on Wednesday 20th therefore we expect to arrive at George Street at approximately 3:00pm. We will text to keep you updated on our journey however we anticipate pick up time will be between 3:00pm and 3:20pm.
