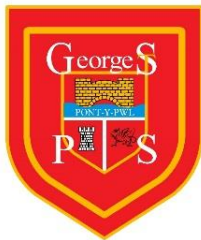

**ARRANGEMENTS FOR THURSDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> & FRIDAY 18<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER**

Tomorrow will be the final day of normal face-to-face teaching for pupils in primary schools in Torfaen. The last two days of this term will be for home learning only.

There is one exception to this arrangement: The Welsh Government has requested all primary schools make provision for children of key workers and vulnerable pupils as identified by the school, to attend in person until the end of the day on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December.

Any parents/carers meeting the criteria on this list who wish for their child(ren) to attend school on Thursday and/or Friday of this week **must notify the school office by phone before 2.00 p.m. on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> December**. This is to ensure that we are able to plan accordingly.

Please note the following:

1. Pupils will not be able to attend without prior agreement and confirmation from school (see *deadline above*).
2. Pupils attending on the 17<sup>th</sup> / 18<sup>th</sup> December will be part of one mixed-age bubble.
3. Pupils are unlikely to be taught / supervised by their usual members of staff or in their usual classroom.
4. Provision for pupils will run between 9.00 and 3.10.
5. Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch as no catering will be available on site.
6. Where pupils have not attended on Monday-Wednesday of this week it is expected that parents/carers will continue to make provision for them at home on Thursday and Friday.
