To boost the use of Welsh, we introduced a Dojo point system where children earn points for playing specific Welsh language games and using Cymraeg both in and out of the classroom. These points contribute to their colour house totals, with the winning house earning a '*parti pitsa*' on the school field! This fun and friendly

competition has really raised the profile of Welsh across the school, with both staff and pupils getting involved – and showing their competitive sides!
