ORGANISATION OF THE DAY

Please note that arrival and pick-up arrangements remain the same as last academic year, as outlined below:

Beginning of the School Day - Arrival Information

To help ensure a smooth start to the day, here's a quick guide to where each year group should enter the school. Staff will be on hand at each entrance to help guide you and your child.

- All children are welcome to enter school grounds via Conway Road and/or School Lane.
- Nursery and Reception (Mrs Davies and Mrs Lloyd) Please use the Early Years gate.
- Reception/Year I (Miss Bodger and Mrs Wood's class) Please use the Year I gate.
- Year 2 (Mrs Fisher and Miss Williams) Please use the Year 2 gate.
- Years 3 and 4 Please use the pathway entrance at the front of the school.
- Years 5 and 6 Please use the steps at the front of the school.
- All entrances will be opened at 8:50am and will close at 9:05am.

KS2 children who enter via Conway Road or School Lane are old enough to walk themselves to class and should do so independently. We kindly ask that adults say goodbye at the school gates and do not walk around the school grounds. Staff will be on hand to direct families.

End of the School Day - Collection Information

To help keep everyone safe and ensure a smooth end to the day, please follow the collection arrangements below:

- Nursery to Year 2 Children should be collected from the same gates they are dropped off at in the morning.
- Years 3 to 6 All children will exit from the front of the school. Please note that children
 will not exit via School Lane or Conway Road.
